Any person not engaged in a business or profession within the district or person or business association, corporation, partnership or estate not in the service district shall have all of the privileges of membership except the vote and eligibility to hold office.

Chamber dues, as adopted by the membership, are based on the number of employees currently working at the firm or business. Any business having a branch office in the Lower Keys, with a main office elsewhere, may calculate dues based upon the number employed at that branch office.

The Chamber, through the District Advisory Committee (a nine member committee composed of various business leaders in our community), is extensively involved with the Monroe County Tourist Development Council and its administration of locally-generated tourist tax monies. The allocation of these funds is carefully monitored, with a view of tailored growth and maximum prosperity for the entire community.

Whether you provide goods and services to residents, seafood for the tables, or accommodations and recreational opportunities for tourists, the Lower Keys Chamber of Commerce is working for you! The Chamber provides an organizational framework within which its members can individually and collectively optimize their time and talents for the betterment of the community.
